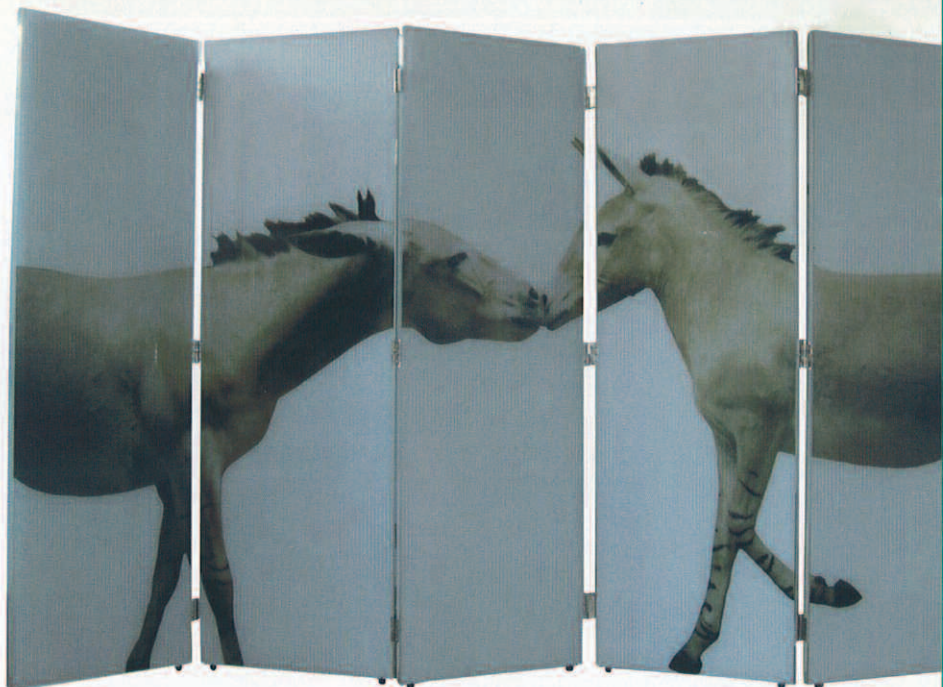

ways to sex up your tack room

1 Have your saddle racks and bridle hooks hand-made by Michael Malleson, maker of the Blacksmiths' Gates at the Globe Theatre and chairman of the British Artist Blacksmiths' Association. (Email Michael@firestudio.co.uk) **2** For flattering filtered light, fit plantation shutters from the California Company in Brighton (0845 123 5661). **3** Store tea-tree hoof oil in this elegant watering can based on a nineteenth-century original from the Château de Broglie in Normandy. Available from Le Prince Jardinier at Chelsea Gardener (020 7352 5656). **4** These charming bronze wall and floor lamps from Objet Insolite's fine-art foundry in Paris have a lovely patina (www.objetinsolite.com). **5** You can be hip as well as tidy by using the Tom Box Project modular storage system for horse rugs, bandages and leg-guards. Change out of your riding kit behind Abigail Lane's 'Kissing Asses' screen by Showroom Dummies (www.showroomdummies.co.uk). **11** For optimum muscle maintenance after taxing rides, install a Lagerholm sauna from the Finnish Sauna company (01579 384836). **12** Equine medicines, hoof-picks and grooming brushes can be beautifully stored in square leather boxes from the Holding Company (020 7352 1600). **13** Banish horsey whiffs with the new Bois Farine from L'Artisan Parfumeur (based on fennel, white iris and cedar) and the classic Pour un Homme by Caron at Harrods. **14** You'll need a practical designer surface for cleaning tack.
